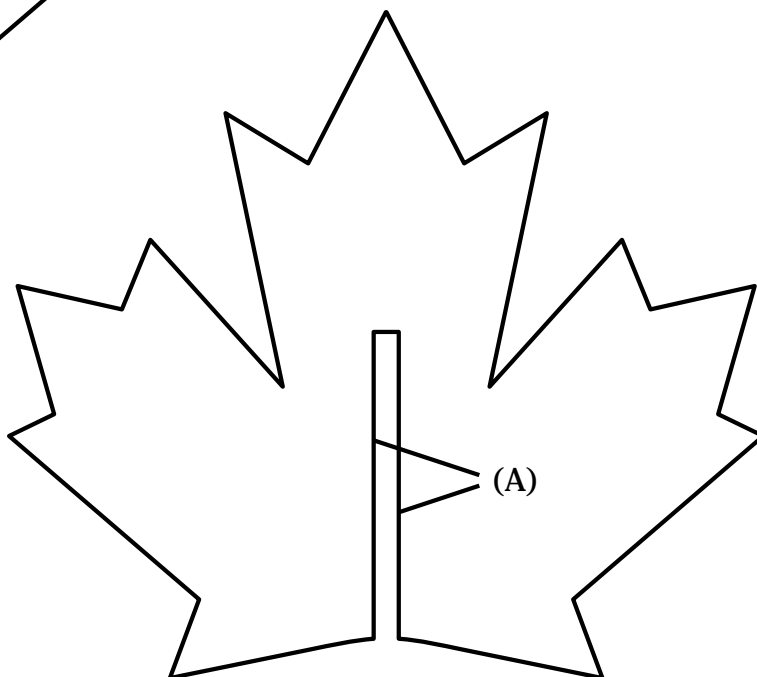
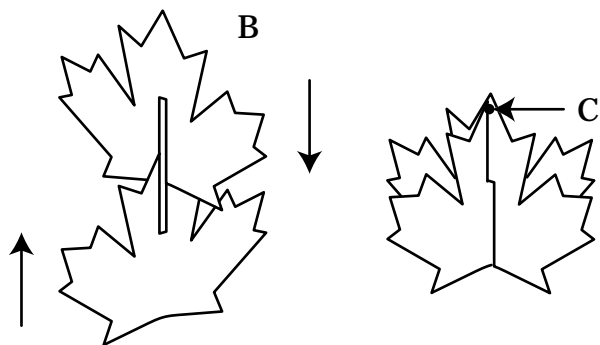
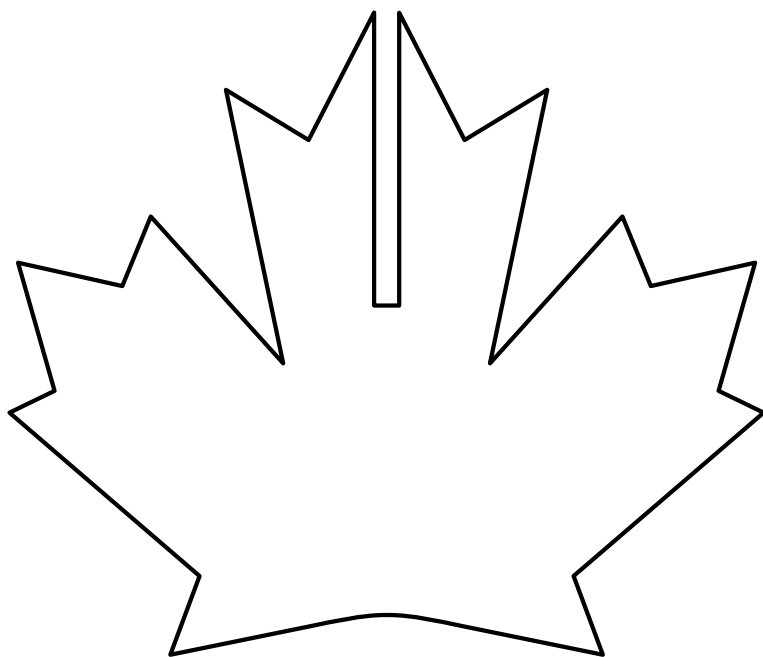


Maple Leaf Tree Ornament

You will need:

- Plywood or cardboard 8" x 5.5"
- White or carpenters glue
- Jig, coping saw, or scissors
- Drill or hole punch for string hole
- String 6" for hanging
- Art supplies to decorate



Instructions

1. Print these instructions and read before starting the project.
2. Make sure you are supervised by a responsible parent or guardian.
3. Cut the two leaf shapes out of the template paper, and trace them onto the wood or card. It is important that you cut the two slots so that they are the same thickness as the wood or card that you are using.
4. Cut the shapes out of the wood or card using the saw or scissors.
5. Place a bead of glue along the inside edge of the vertical cuts (A) of one piece.
6. Slide the slots together as shown in figure B.
7. Let the glue dry.
8. Drill or punch a small hole in the top of the ornament as shown in figure C.
9. Tie the string in a loop through the hole.
10. Decorate the ornament with paint and other art materials.
